

The Bible in Hebrews 13:8 says "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and forever." Know that His power is still the same today as it was in the beginning and there is nothing too difficult for God, not even your own case.

The Lord will reach out His hand and touch you today right where you are. He is touching you right now and He is effecting a healing change to your body. Receive your healing in Jesus name!

The Healing of The Centurion's Servant

- The Power of Intercession

When a loved one is sick, it is a personal experience. We also feel the pain of the loved one in the sickness. We often pray for the recovery of our loved ones. We pray even without realizing we are praying. God answers those prayers. James 5:14 says "Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him." This is simply the prayer of intercession.

Anytime you pray for someone, you are interceding on their behalf. Any time you beseech God on behalf of a family member, friend, loved one, co-worker. You are interceding on behalf of that person. Therefore we must take the prayers of intercession very seriously. You must not wait until you are sick to pray for healing or call upon the Lord. Have faith that when you intercede on behalf of anyone, the Lord will hear you "[a]nd the prayer of faith shall save the sick." James 5:16.

The Roman Centurion interceded on behalf of his servant and the Lord answered him and healed his servant.

"And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, beseeching him,

And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented.

And Jesus saith unto him, I will come and heal him.

The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.

For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this man, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it.

When Jesus heard it, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.

And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven.

But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour." Matthew 8:5-13

No matter how lowly placed you are, God has given you healing. He healed the servant of a Roman Centurion, He will heal you. Jesus healed a servant based on the intercession of the master. Jesus today will heal you today based on our prayers for you. He will heal you based on the prayers of the elders of the church for you. He will heal you based on the love He has for you. After healing you, He will make you whole. He will also promote you. Receive your healing in Jesus name.

When you intercede you stand in the gap for someone. Jesus stood in the gap for us. He is forever interceding on our behalf. In Ezekiel 22:30 God sought for a man to make up the hedge and stand in the gap before Him for the land. How wonderful it is to be found standing in the gap for the healing of another.

Moses stood in the gap and interceded for the people of God in pleading with the Lord for mercy and God held back His hand from consuming the nation with His wrath. Exodus 32:7-14.

- Faith to Intercede for Healing

You must have faith like the Centurion. The faith of the centurion established the healing for his servant. The Centurion interceded on behalf of his servant. God answered him. It is for this reason that the prayer of intercession is effective. Your prayer of intercession for all those who are sick is effective.

The Centurion effectively interceded on behalf of his servant and believed for the healing of his servant and it came to pass that his servant was healed even without Jesus having to go to the Centurion's house.

The characteristics of a successful intercessor is persistence and determination, patience, faith, and severe self discipline and selflessness. Be all of these interceding for each other.

No matter how terrible the sickness is in your body, He will heal you. Receive your healing right where you stand in Jesus name. Some of use may believe that it is only if we contribute mightily to the church of God in monetary terms, that is the only reason God will heal us. No, He heals us because He loves us. His love is sufficient for all of our needs including healing.

Healing was already bought and paid for by the stripes of Jesus as He hung on the cross. No matter your situation in life, the Lord knows about you. He cares for you. He loves you and will heal your infirmities. If the earthly father will care, nuture and love his child, how much more our heavenly father.

Healed Simon's Mother In-Law

Jesus went to Simon's house and the mother in law of Simon was sick. You know if your mother in law is sick, you will have no peace in the house. Your wife will bother you to "do something". Simon knew Jesus. He knew he had to "do something". He definitely was glad to see Jesus come to his house. He immediately started pleading with Jesus for the healing of his mother in-law. The bible says:

"And he arose out of the synagogue, and entered into Simon's house. And Simon's wife's mother was taken with a great fever; and they be sought him for her.

And he stood over her, and rebuked the fever; and it left her: and immediately she arose and ministered unto them." I Luke 4:38-39

Jesus rebuked the fever, and immediately the fever left her. We have the power to rebuke sickness. Rebuke the sickness now and it will leave your body. He will touch you were you are today. He will lift you up where you are today. You are immediately healed where you are today. In Jesus name. Note that the healing of Jesus requires no recovery time. Immediately you are healed, your strength is renewed. The Bible says that the mother in-law of Simon immediately arose and ministered unto them. May you be renewed in your strength right where you stand in the name of Jesus.

<u>Healed The Leper</u>

While preaching in Galilee, Jesus healed a leper. With much conviction a leper came to Him saying, if you *will*, you *can* make me clean. Jesus immediately put forth His hand and touched the leper saying, I *will*, be you clean. The leper was healed immediately.

"And there came a leper to him, beseeching him, and kneeling down to him, and saying unto him, If thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.

And Jesus, moved with compassion, put forth his hand, and touched him, and saith unto him, I will; be thou clean.

And as soon as he had spoken, immediately the leprosy departed from him, and he was cleansed." Mark 1:40-42

Healed The Demon Possessed Man

Strengthen your faith in believing that He can and will cast out devils and unclean spirits from you. In Mark 5:2, 8 & 13 that is exactly what Jesus Christ did.

"And when [Jesus] was come out of the ship, immediately there met him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit,"

"[Jesus] said unto him, Come out of the man, thou unclean spirit."

"And the unclean spirits went out." Mark 5:2, 8 & 13.

When a man with unclean spirit saw Him, the spirit immediately recognized Him as the Son of God and became afraid. Jesus spoke to the unclean spirit and ordered them out of the man. Immediately the spirit left the man. Every form of evil spirit troubling you will recognize Jesus Christ in your life today in the name of Jesus and will become afraid. The spirit is cast out of you right where you stand today. You are set free in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. For "If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed." John 8:36.

Heal A Woman Having An Issue of Blood

The stigma surrounding certain diseases can cause us to lose hope for our healing. Every sickness is of the devil and is not from the plan of God for us. We must not be embarrassed or feel shamed in any way. We must possess our healing in Jesus name. In the book of Mark a certain woman had an issue of blood for twelve years. If a woman has an issue of blood, she most likely will not enjoy the benefits of a marital home and neither will the husband. She will

not be able to go far from her house for fear of being overwhelmed by the blood. She will not be able to engage in many normal every day activities.

Desperate the woman visited many physicians with no respite. Rather, her sickness got worse. All she needed to do was touch His garment. She trusted and had faith that He will heal her. She was immediately healed. Jesus confirmed her healing when He said "your faith has made you whole".

"And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years,
And had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all
that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse." Mark
5:25-26.

No matter how long you have had the sickness, He can and will heal you. No matter how embarrassing your sickness, He can and will heal you. No matter what the doctors say. He can and will heal you. From the healing you will be whole and will be in peace.

Contact with God can make a difference in your life. Be touched by His word. Be touched by His love. Be touched by His virtue. For all these to occur, you must first believe.

"When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched his garment.

And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of that plague.

And Jesus, immediately knowing in himself that virtue had gone out of him, turned him about in the press, and said, Who touched my clothes?" Mark 5:27-30.

Know that Jesus knows you. He knows when you have touch Him. He will look for you. He will confirm your believe in Him by making you whole. In Mark 5:32 "He looked round to see her that had done this thing." In Mark 5:34 He said to her "Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague."

Believe and you will be healed right where you stand. Reach out and touch the word of God and believe. Touch the clothes of the Lord and you are healed right there where you stand. He will meet your needs according to His riches in glory.

In Matthew He touched the eyes of the blind and asked if they believe He could heal them. They said yes and they were healed. Straightaway they could see.

"And when he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus saith unto them, Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto him, Yea, Lord.

And their eyes were opened;" Matthew 9:28-30

May you receive your sight in Jesus name. May your eyes be opened right where you are in the name of Jesus. May you possess all things that you see in the name of Jesus. In all these things, the people had faith. They believed that Jesus could heal them. Romans 9:33 says "whosoever believeth on Him shall not be ashamed." The people who needed healing were not

ashamed, rather they were healed according to their faith. May you receive your healing in the name of Jesus.

CHAPTER THREE

Develop Faith

Develop Faith

Have faith. Faith is the *sine qua non* in the life of a Christian. It simply is the indispensable and essential action, condition, or ingredient for a man to walk with God. In fact, Christians are told that "without faith it is impossible to please Him." Hebrews 11:6. If we as His children want to please Him then we must have faith.

How much faith must you have, you may ask yourself. Jesus already stated the size of the faith needed to move mountain when He said:

"If ye have faith as a grain of a mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to younder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you". Matthew 12:20.

But how do you have faith in the midst of tribulations and trials. Romans 10:17 tells us that "faith then cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." Therefore, we must listen to the word of God. We must not forsake the gathering of the brethren. We must walk in the light of the word of God. Nothing must separate us from the love of God. God loves us. He created us in His image. His image is not sick. His image is not deformed. We must appropriate for ourselves the wholeness of God and receive the blessing of healing from Him.

Today we are tempted to put our faith in many things. However, not all are that dependable. Some are actually dangerous. Some people trust in God, others in money, friends, self, political leaders, or military power. Still others trust in science, other experts, astrology or fortune- tellers. However, you must "Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding." Proverbs 3:5. If you trust in the Lord, you will wait upon Him. Remember:

"But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint." Isaiah 40:31.

Whatever it is that you desire of the Lord, He wants you to walk with Him. Psalm 37:5 says: "Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass." God will heal you today. Just trust in Him and He will bring your healing to pass.

It all starts with having faith in Christ.

Pray With Me

We are commanded in James 5:16 to confess our faults one to another, and pray one for another, that we may be healed. Note that in praying, our prayers must be effectual and fervent, for such a prayer offered by a righteous man availeth much¹. Pray with conviction and passion asking for healing. Believe that you have received your healing when you pray.

Pray With Me: Lord, by the power of our Lord Jesus Christ, drive away from me all forms of sickness and disease. Restore strength to my body and joy to my spirit, so that in my renewed health, I may bless and serve you, now and forevermore.

Keep Praying For We Must Pray Without Ceasing

"Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much." James 5:14-16

Pray With Me: My Lord and My God, I come to you in the name of Jesus. Lord I thank you for your living Word, and for your promises. I know that through faith in Christ I have been declared righteous before you! Your Word says that if your spirit dwells in me, that you will also give life to my mortal body through the Spirit of Jesus (Romans 8:11). I claim this Word as mine right now, and I take a hold of it by faith in the name of Jesus!

My Lord and My God I know it is your will for your children to be healed from all sicknesses. I stand believing that "Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven." (Matthew 6:10) It is not Your will that there be any sick on earth or in Heaven, therefore it cannot be Your will for me to remain sick. My Lord your Word declares that my body is a member of Christ (1 Corinthians 6:15). If I am a member of Christ, surely sicknesses and diseases are not mine because they are not of Him, therefore I refuse, reject and cast them out in the name of Jesus!

CHAPTER FOUR

Healing Declaration

Healing declaration:

I declare by faith that my body is healed both externally and internally from head to toe. I declare this healing in the name of Jesus. I know that death and life are in the power of the tongue, and I choose life and healing! I speak life and I speak healing! Lord I receive your Word by faith and stand under your protection. I will continue to dwell in the secret place of the most High and continue to abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; and in Him will I trust.

Surely He shall deliver me from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence. He shall cover me with His feathers, and under His wings shall I trust: His truth shall be my shield and buckler. I will not be afraid of any terror at night; or any arrows that fly by day; or any pestilence that walks in darkness; or any destruction that was during the day. A thousand shall fall at my side, and ten thousand at my right hand; but nothing evil shall come near me. Only with my eyes shall I behold and see the reward of the wicked.

Lord, be now my habitation. Your Word says, because I have made you my habitation, my refuge, no evil shall fall upon me, neither shall any plague come near my dwelling. Give your angels charge over me, to keep me in all my ways. I trust that they shall bear me up in their hands, so that I will not strike my foot against a stone. Lord your Word says I will tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon will I trample under my feet.

Surrender for Healing

You must surrender everything to Jesus Christ. You must surrender everything that you are and everything that you are striving to be to Jesus Christ. He will perfect it for you for He is "the author and finisher of our faith." Hebrews 12:2.

You must also open the deepest recesses of your heart and invite the Holy Spirit to dwell inside of you. Offer your life, heart, mind, body, soul, spirit, all your hopes, plans and dreams. Surrender your past, present and future problems, habits, character defects, attitudes, livelihood, resources, finances, medical coverage, occupation and all your relationships. Let God take control for He sits right now at the right hand of the throne of God advocating on our behalf. **Pray With Me:** I give you my health, disabilities, family, marriage, children and all that I am and cherish. I ask you to take control over every aspect of my life. I surrender to you all my hurts, pains, worries, doubts, fears and anxieties, and I ask you to wash me clean. I release everything into your compassionate care and loving tenderness. Amen.

May the Lord speak to you clearly today wherever you may be. May He open your ears to hear His voice. May He open your heart to commune with Him more deeply. May He open doors that need to be opened on your behalf and close doors that need to be closed. May He set your feet upon the straight and narrow road that leads to a fulfilling and everlasting life. Amen.

CHAPTER FIVE

The Prayer of Healing

"Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions.

Wash me throughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.

For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me. Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest.

Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me.

Behold, thou desirest truth in the inward parts: and in the hidden part thou shalt make me to know wisdom.

Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

Make me to hear joy and gladness; that the bones which thou hast broken may rejoice.

Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities.

Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.

Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me.

Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free spirit." Psalm 51:1-12.

Healing Prayer of Isaiah 53:4-5

"Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed." Isaiah 53:4-5.

Thank the Lord for His enduring love and mercy. He came into the world to set you free from the power of darkness. He embraced a violent death on the cross to pay the penalty on your behalf. He suffered the scourging at the pillar, taking the sickness of humanity upon His own flesh, so that you could be healed. Right where you stand the Lord will touch you and heal you in Jesus name.

The Lord's Prayer

Most of us find it difficult to articulate what we want when we pray. You are not alone.

Just committing "The Lord's Prayer" to heart and speaking it out can be effective.



"After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen." Matthew 6:9-15.

Even when we are articulate, we may not know what to pray for. God has prepared the Holy Spirit to act on your behalf right now. The Spirit of the Lord will make intercessions for you right where you are.

"Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered." Romans 8:26.

CHAPTER SIX

The Love of Christ

The Love of Christ

Nothing and no one can separate us from the love of Christ but sin. Flee from sin "for the wages of sin is death and the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." Romans 6:23. Eternal life is a gift promised to us. We will not die but live, and declare the works of the Lord. Psalm 118:17. We will have life through Jesus Christ, and have it more abundantly. John 10:10. The Lord has promised us with long life and salvation. "With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation." Psalm 91:16. For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 8:38-39.

God so loved us that while we were yet sinners Christ died for us. Romans 5:8. How much does He love us, you may ask. God says He is rich in mercy towards us. He has great love

for us. He loves us with this great love. He loved us even when we were dead to sins. His love brings about His grace for us. His grace for us is sufficient in all circumstances. "And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee". 2 Corinthians 12:9. His mercies endureth forever. His love abounds for us.

"But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Chris, by grace ye are saved." Ephesians 2:4-5.

We have all seen how some mothers can quiet a child just by a simple display of love when the child is crying. So too can the Lord quiet us when we face stormy days in our lives. May your storms be quieted by the love of God right where you stand in Jesus name. Amen.

The Lord's Prayer Matthew 6:9-15

Most of us find it difficult to articulate what we want when we pray. You are not alone.

Just committing "The Lord's Prayer" to heart and speaking it out can be effective.

The Lord's Prayer



"After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil:

For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen." Matthew 6:9-15.

Even when we are articulate, we may not know what to pray for. God has prepared the Holy Spirit to act on your behalf right now. The Spirit of the Lord will make intercessions for you right where you are.

"Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered."

Romans 8:26.

CHAPTER SEVEN

Effect of Prayers

Expect A Miracle When You Pray

We have to first believe in the power of our Lord Jesus Christ to perform miracles. We must also believe that the power still exist today.

Miracle of Water to Wine. On the third day of a marriage ceremony, Jesus was called along with His disciples and He was informed by His mother that there was no wine. Understand that if there is no wine, the wedding will eventually grind to a halt, thus this was a very difficult situation that could have possibly stopped the wedding. Jesus performed a miracle that saved the day and the wedding even bringing joy to the ruler of the feast.

"And there were set there six waterpots of stone, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing two or three firkins apiece.

Jesus saith unto them, Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim.

And he saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare it.

When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom." John 2:6-9.

We must believe that the same power He had to change water to wine exists today. He can change your sorrow to joy. He can change your pain to pleasure. He can change your loss to

gain. He can change your circumstances no matter what they are right now and right where you stand.

Miracle of Healing of the Nobleman's Son. In John 4:46-54, Jesus healed the son of the nobleman. The son was very sick and he ask Jesus to come before his son dies. Jesus said to him, "Go, your son will live".

"The nobleman saith unto him, Sir, come down ere my child die.

Jesus saith unto him, Go thy way; thy son liveth. And the man believed the word that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way.

And as he was now going down, his servants met him, and told him, saying, Thy son liveth." John 4:49-51.

The book of John says he took Jesus at His word and departed. That is an exercise of faith by the nobleman. We need faith for the healing to take place and for the person healed to be made whole. The miracle of the healing took place immediately for as the nobleman was on his way, he was met with news that his son was living. He was also informed that the fever left his son "yesterday, at the seventh hour" John 4:52. He then realized that this was the exact time at which Jesus had said to him, "thy son liveth". Believe in the word of God and it will come to pass for you.

Miracle of Raising the Dead. Most of us know the story of Lazarus. However, did you know that Jesus also raised the daughter of Jairus? The Gospels of Matthew, Mark and Luke describe a miracle in which Jesus restores to life Jairus' daughter.

"And, behold, there cometh one of the rulers of the synagogue, Jairus by name; and when he saw him, he fell at his feet,

And besought him greatly, saying, My little daughter lieth at the point of death: I pray thee, come and lay thy hands on her, that she may be healed; and she shall live.

And Jesus went with him; and much people followed him, and thronged him.

While he yet spake, there came from the ruler of the synagogue's house certain which said, Thy daughter is dead: why troublest thou the Master any further?

As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, he saith unto the ruler of the synagogue, Be not afraid, only believe.

And he suffered no man to follow him, save Peter, and James, and John the brother of James.

And he cometh to the house of the ruler of the synagogue, and seeth the tumult, and them that wept and wailed greatly.

And when he was come in, he saith unto them, Why make ye this ado, and weep? the damsel is not dead, but sleepeth.

And they laughed him to scorn. But when he had put them all out, he taketh the father and the mother of the damsel, and them that were with him, and entereth in where the damsel was lying.

And he took the damsel by the hand, and said unto her, Talitha cumi; which is, being interpreted, Damsel, I say unto thee, arise.

And straightway the damsel arose, and walked; for she was of the age of twelve years. And they were astonished with a great astonishment." Mark 5:22-24 & 35-42.

Jairus was a synagogue leader who pleaded with Jesus to come to his house because his daughter was dying. While Jesus was walking to Jairus' house, a woman suffering from internal bleeding touched Jesus and was healed. Mark 5:25-34. Before Jesus arrived at Jairus' house, Jairus was told that his daughter was already dead.

Jesus said to Jairus not to be afraid, just believe, and she will be healed. It is time to cast away all fears from us. Fear is simply False Evidence Appearing Real. A mirage. An illusion. An untrue representation of the facts. The only fact worth noting is the word of God. His word says we are healed by His stripes. That settles it.

I beseech you to let the warmth of the healing love of God flood your entire being, so that your body will function the way it was created to function; whole, complete, and renewed in perfect health. I ask this through our Lord, Jesus Christ. Amen.

Generational Curses Are Broken

There are generational curses that we must break. Galatians 3:13 shows that Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us. We are therefore free of the generational curses. Furthermore, God has already said that the son shall not bear the iniquity of the father. Therefore, the iniquities of your father shall not be upon you in Jesus name.

According to 2 Corinthians 5:17 "[]... if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new." Be renewed in the name of Jesus.

Know that all things are passed away for you. Your sins are passed away. Your sicknesses are passed away. Your financial struggles are passed. You are now a new creature in Christ.

2 Chronicles 25:4 also tells us that "[T]he fathers shall not die for the children, neither shall the children die for the fathers, but every man shall die for his own sin." Therefore, you are free from the sins of your fathers and that is the truth. "And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." John 8:32. You now know the truth and the truth has set you free.

We Forgive and We Are Forgiven

It is important to ask for God's grace to forgive every person in your past that has ever hurt you. Forgive your father and mother and ask to be set free from all forms of mental, emotional and psychological ailments. Forgive your brothers and sisters for their sibling rivalry, selfishness and divisiveness that have caused strife within your family. Forgive your children and release them from the curse of the land. Forgive your friends, coworkers and neighbors for all their harmful actions and the unkind words they have spoken against you.

Remember that you must forgive others if you want God to forgive you as well. Forgive your greatest enemies and those whom you have vowed you will never forgive. Break those vows right now by the power of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Sometimes we want someone to apologize before we forgive them. It is not helpful to hold them in our unrepentance just to get an apology from them. Forgive them. Denounce all forms of anger, bitterness and resentment, and command every evil spirit that has entered your body through the lack of forgiveness to leave now. Be filled with your love, peace, patience, kindness, generosity and self-control. May the healing hand of Jesus rest upon you now as you bless all those who have hurt you. Amen.

Confirm Your Healing With Prayer



Remember that when healing people Jesus often said you are healed "according to your faith..." It is important to have faith that an event has occurred even though you have not seen evidence of such occurrence.

"Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen." Hebrews 11:1.

Substance is generally physical matter of which a person or thing consists and which has a tangible, solid presence. You can touch substance. Substance provides the evidence in all things. You will be able to see the evidence of your healing if you apply faith. Once you see the evidence of what you hope for, it will come to pass.

Have faith and pray believing you are healed. Receive your healing wherever you stand. Be whole in Jesus name. Take on the image of Christ and be made whole in that image wherever you are right now. Amen.

Healing Scriptures

Meditate on the following scripture passages day and night. They have the power to bring healing and strength to your heart, mind, body, soul and spirit, thus I repeat, meditate on them day and night. God will speak to your situation through His written Word if you allow Him.

Accept the Word of God as the truth and the final report.

Allow your faith to grow to the point where you can command the mountain of sickness, hardship and despair out of your life. For according to Mark 9:23, Jesus said unto him, if thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth. Also in Mark 11:23–24, Jesus said:

"For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

²⁴ Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them." Mark 11:23–24
